Non-profit in Madison, WI

- •Affordable housing options for people with disabilities
- •Started in 1992 by a group of parents
- Developed and owns Elven Sted



Elven Sted

Multi-family housing development

- Located in Stoughton, WI
- •Thirty-two units of new multi-family housing
- •Several units are adapted to meet accessibility needs of family members with disabilities
- •Low to mid-income residents

Howard Mandeville

Executive Director of Movin' Out

- •First envisioned a rain garden in the retention pond with wetland prairie species
- •Saw the potential for a micro-enterprise with the sale of high-value, hand-harvested wild flower seeds
- •Movin' Out obtained grant funding to explore the feasibility of such a project, develop a work plan, and initiate planning to identify and assist an entrepreneur to take on this project



The Retention Pond

- •Mitigates runoff from the Elven Sted paved areas and also from the immediate neighborhood around Elven Sted
- •After passing through the retention ponds the storm water travels to the Yahara River
- •The area to be used for planting is just under ¼ acre.

Brittany's Support Broker, ARC-Wisconsin


- Coordinated community support
